50 years «jogging with brains»

Last but not least it is thanks to the founding of the Basel Orienteering Group (OLG) 50 years ago that this sport and its competitions have long had a firm place in the region's sport calendar. At that time, my pre-predecessor Stefan Cornaz was one of the driving forces in the OLG Basel. With his book «Jogging mit Köpfchen» (written together with Roland Hirter) he had described the attractiveness of this orienteering sport to the point.

Even if I am not one of those active in this sport myself, a lot of what is essential in orienteering reminds me of my work as a member of the government.

Like an orienteering runner, I am constantly faced with the challenge of finding the optimal route as quickly as possible through what is often still uncharted territory. And just like out in nature, it is also important in politics to prevent headless pursuit.

Also, as a politician, if you don't want to lose your bearings, you better trust your own (inner) compass, showing you which path leads quickest to the finish line and measurable results. As a member of government, I can also learn from orienteering how important it is to pace oneself. Whoever runs at the physical limit all the time can easily get lost and has to spend a lot of time and energy to get back on the right track.

Even more such parallels could be found, of course. But I don't want to overstrain it, because the charm of the combination of swift legs and alert mind should be actively experienced by yourself in nature. I wish therefore that the 50th anniversary of OLG Basel will not be the last one we can celebrate together.





Pre-start and Start Procedure	Valid for all classes, including «Open» (Special permit of Swiss Orienteering): - 4': Bib number check, SI-Card clear and check - 3': Self-service control descriptions (IOF symbols) - 2': lay-out of map boxes - 1': Start check, Access to map boxes - Start signal: Map may only be taken out of the box at the time of the start signal. Each runner bears himself/herself the responsibility for taking the correct map out of the map box.

Control Points	White-orange control flag according to Competition Rules, and SPORTident units (AIR+ activated). Check control point with SI-Card. If SI unit does not function properly (no acoustic and no optic signal) or SI unit is missing, punch with pincer on the map in the R field. At the finish line inform the staff, mark your map with your name and deposit it for control. When reading out the SI-Card the staff has to be informed accordingly. 
